Free Home Covid-19 Tests

Americans can now sign up to get free home Covid-19 tests from the federal government.

How do I order the tests?

Go to covidtests.gov and sign up. You'll need to enter your name, email and residential address. You should receive an email confirming your order and providing tracking information.

How many tests can I get?

Four tests will be shipped to each residential address, regardless of household size.

When will I receive them?

The US Postal Service will begin shipping the tests in late January, according to the covidtests.gov website. The tests should ship within 7 to 12 days.

What if I don't have internet access?

The federal government is also setting up a hotline to request the tests. It is currently being piloted and additional details will be available at the end of the week.
