Blacks In Catholic History Moments

Did You Know...

...that of the one billion Roman Catholics in the world today, at least 20% (200 Million) are Black??

Africa alone has 130 Million Black Catholics. In fact, the largest Catholic Church building in the world is found in Africa, the Cathedral in Yamoussoukro, the capital city of the West African country known as Cote d'ivoire. During the selection of the latest pope, many scoffed at the idea that one of the 12 Black cardinals would be picked. However, it would not have been the first. There have been three, all of them have been declared saints, that is, and the Catholic Church feels certain that all three went to heaven. It's interesting to note there are hundreds of revered icons that are statues of Christ and his mother throughout Europe which picture them as Black figures. The last pope, John Paul II had a Black icon in his personal chapel that he prayed before every day. Black people have been and are a very vibrant part of the church.

Living Faith My Shepherd and King

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. Psalm 23:1

Today, on the feast of Christ the King, we discover what that old-fashioned word kingship really means. And it has nothing to do with power, wealth, subjection or elitism.

The prophet Ezekiel, long before Christ was born, saw that God's desire is to care for us—all of us, and each of us—in the trials and troubles of life, especially when we are most vulnerable (Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-16). Jesus' parable of the sheep and goats tells us we too can become good shepherds, tending and caring for one another. (See Matthew 25:31-46.) In this we become like him whom we love. And in this he takes delight.
