
Sacrament of Marriage: Pre-Cana is a Diocesan Requirement. Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance.

Living Faith 'Their Eyes Were Opened'

With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him... Luke 24:31

The first time I toured Rome, I saw all the usual sites: St. Peter's Basilica, the Colosseum, the Appian Way. Yet, it wasn't until I visited the Basilica of St. Paul's Outside the Walls that I suddenly realized...this was the same Rome that Paul visited, the one where Peter was martyred. I'd read their letters, of course, I knew their stories, but in some unconscious corner of my brain, they were just that: stories. Standing in that holy place, I understood viscerally for the first time that Peter and Paul were real.

Strange, isn't it? I imagine that was sort of how the disciples felt on the road to Emmaus. They'd heard a rumor of the Risen Lord and were discussing it with a stranger on the way. Then suddenly, there he was: the Risen Christ, right there in their midst! What else might we see of we allow the Lord to open our eyes?
