

And now, O priests,if you do not...give glory to my name, says the Lord of hosts, I will send a curse upon you and of your blessing I will make a curse.

Malachi 2:1-2

God through Malachi, warns his priests: If they—the person who bring God's blessings into the world—turn away from God's ways, they provoke the opposite. We've witnessed this to be true. We've been hurt and scandalized by the sins of some errant priests and certain leaders. The fallout has been devastating.
