

Please keep in mind the following stipulations:

- Each item cannot exceed 2 feet for length, width and height.
- We are asking that people bring in blessed items only.
- Do not bring in cremated remains of a loved one or pet.
- Once the items have been brought in for proper disposal they cannot be retrieved.
