# Most Holy Body 🕀 É Blood of Christ 📕

Jesus is the reminder of who God is in our lives and through the Eucharist he remains present in our lives in an ordinary but extraordinary way. He uses the ordinary things of life—bread and wine—to stay with us. We believe that he is really though mysteriously, present through the ordinary signs of bread and wine.

You and I constantly need reminders of what is most precious in life. It is all too easy to forget what is of the greatest value. The Eucharist is a way of keeping the memory of Christ alive in our hearts. Just as you and I don't always think of what our friendships and marriages mean in our lives, but need reminders now and then, so too do we need to be reminded of who we are in God's sight and in the sight of one another.

We need to be faithful to the signs we make to God and to one another. The signs have to be true. Most of us feel revolted by the phony kiss or endearing words that some people use. These signs are not true to what they profess to say. When we take the Eucharist we are pledging our faithfulness in love to God and to each other. Jesus has been faithful to death and we are called to be faithful during our whole lives.
