Matthew 14:27

Today's readings offer three prominent examples of how to follow God. Elijah's obedience is rewarded with encountering the presence of God. In faithful witness, Paul prays for "[his] own people, his kindred." And St. Peter—oh Peter! - longs to jump headfirst into the arms of God even if it means possibly falling flat on his face, crying humbly, "Lord, save me!"

One inspiration in my life is a Sacred Heart sister, Rosemary Nyirumbe, a spiritual mother to refugees, to women kidnapped into slavery and to abandoned and orphaned children in her native Uganda. When I grow up, I want to be just like her.


Thank you, Lord, for the beacons of light in my life!
