Did You Know...

...that the Oblate Sisters of Providence in Baltimore, is the first and oldest religious congregation for women of color in the United States?

Haitian immigrant and educator, Mother Mary Lange, and three companions founded this order in 1829, when Maryland was still a slave state. Under great risk, these sisters dedicated themselves to serving orphans and educating black children. Also around that time, Mother Lange founded Baltimore's historic Saint Francis Academy. It continues to thrive today as a co-ed high school that educates mainly inner city African American and Hispanic youth. Mother's Lange's candidacy for sainthood began in 1990.
